OUR BIG NEWS:

After spay/neutering 1523 cats in 2010 (our record year thus far) we're off to a great start in 2011.

January 30th found us at the American Legion in Kettle Falls where we spay/neutered 141 cats.

On February 20th we fixed 117 cats at the Chewelah Civic Center.

But March 27th was just an extra special day. It was a rainy Sunday in Springdale at the Camas Valley Grange. And although the number, 106, may have been our smallest clinic thus far this year, it was at this little community, where we've been numerous times before, that we fixed our 5,000th cat! Miss 5000th Kitty was a pretty little Siamese mix belonging to Stevens County Fire Fighter, Tom Brown. We are unsure if she actually enjoyed her stay with us or not, but we all agreed that her future looks more pleasant for both herself and her owners now that she is no longer able to reproduce. The celebration didn't last long as the volunteers and veterinarians enjoyed a quick piece of cake and set to work on the 5,001st cat.
